MPBN Announces Public Screenings of Doc Martin Season 6 Premiere

(Portland/Bangor/Lewiston)— The Maine Public Broadcasting Network announces two free screenings of the Season 6 premiere of *Doc Martin* before the show is broadcast across the state. The first event will be held at the Port City Music Hall in Portland on Wednesday, February 26th and the second screening will take place at The GRAND in Ellsworth on Thursday, March 6th. Doc Martin is a British Television comedy drama series starring Martin Clunes in the title role. The show is set in the fictional seaside village of Portwenn and filmed on location in the village of Port Isaac, Cornwall, England, with most interior scenes shot in a converted local barn. Five series aired between 2004 and 2011, together with a feature-length special that aired on Christmas Day 2006. The sixth series will begin airing on Thursday, March 13 at 9:00 pm on MPBN Television.
